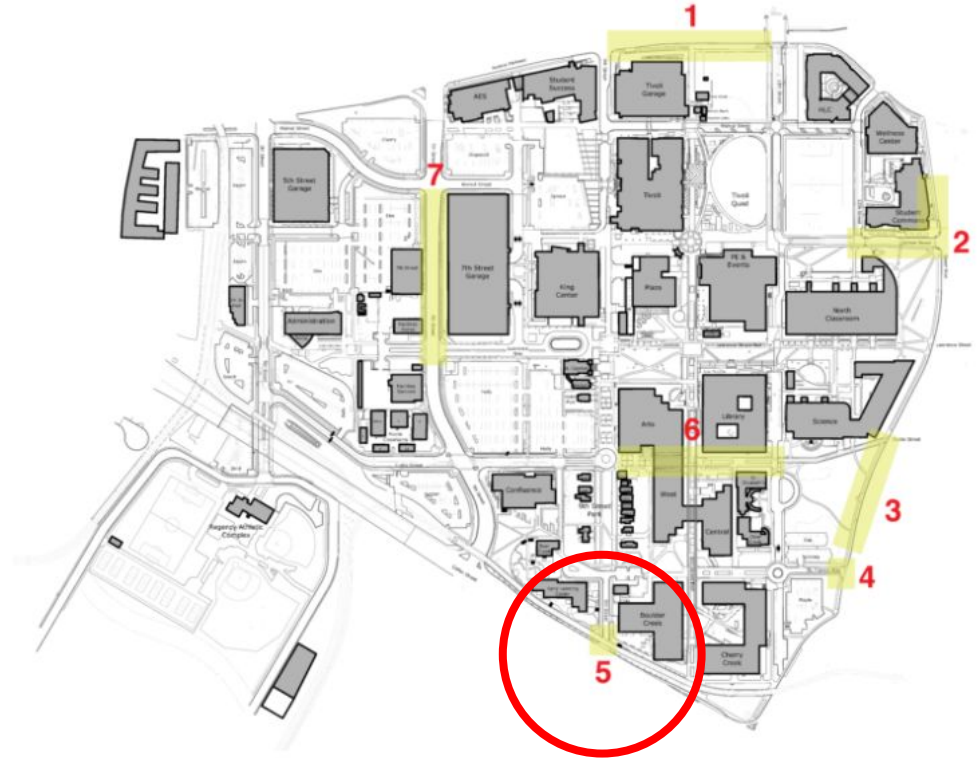

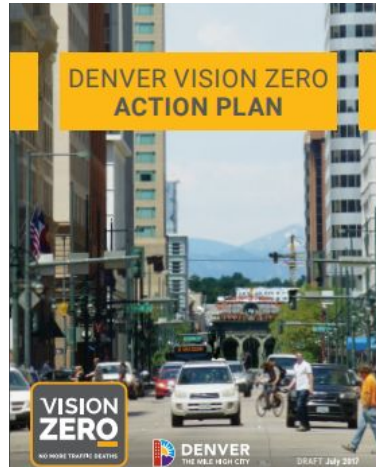

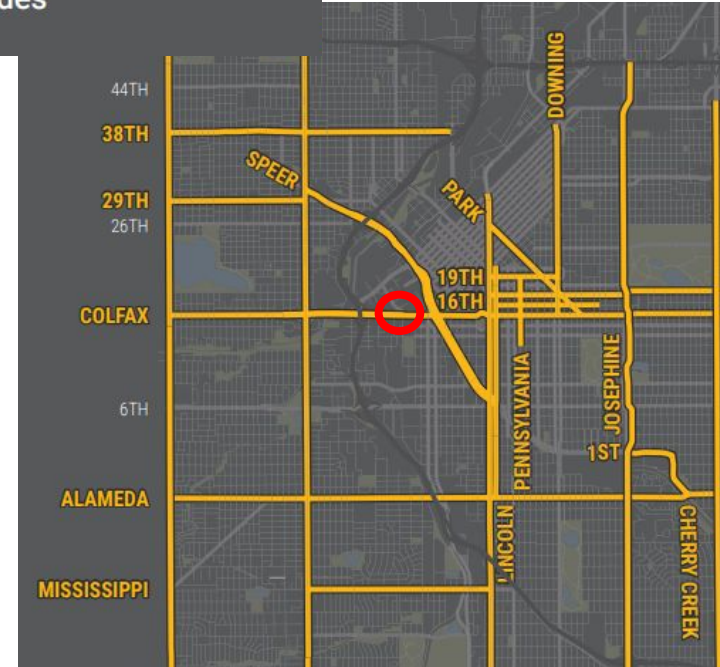
# Mariposa Street

All Modes





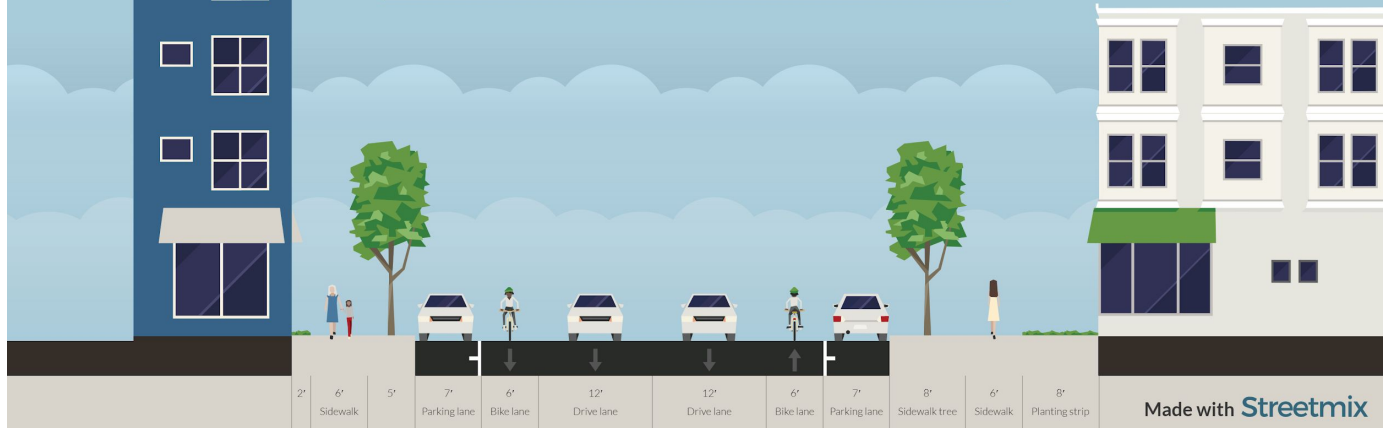

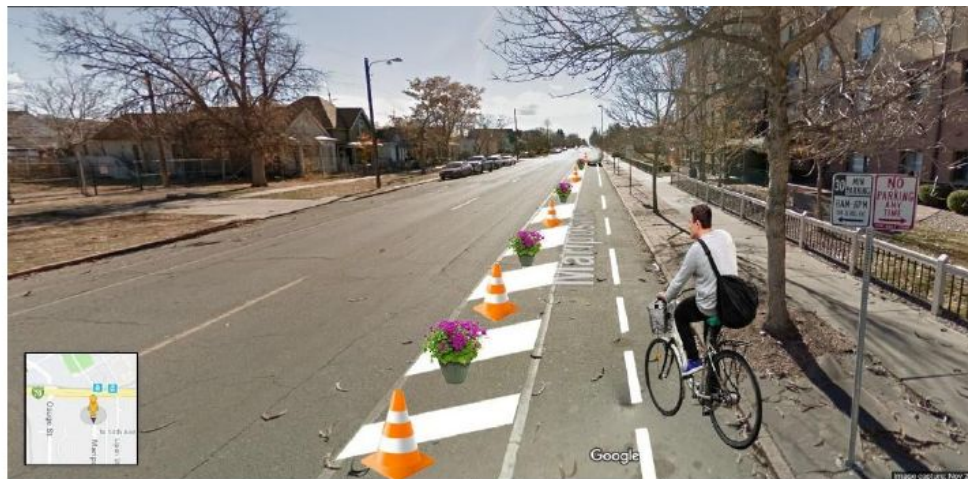








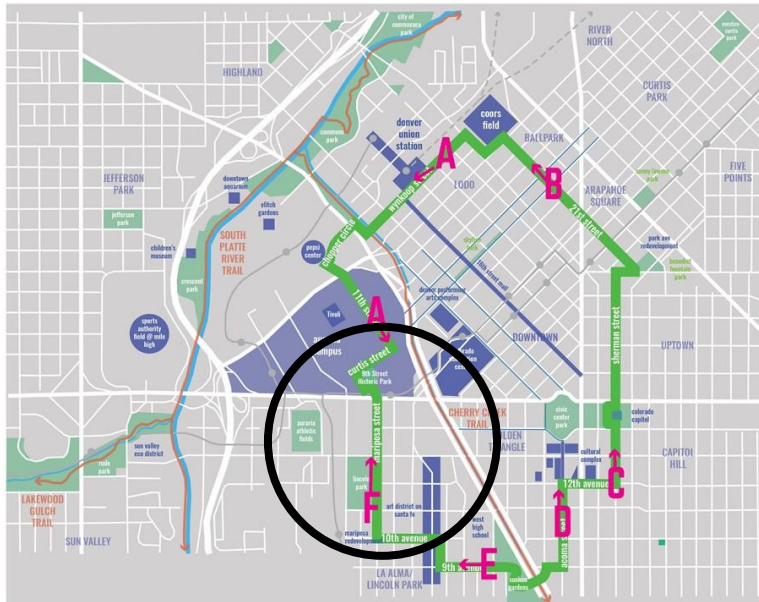
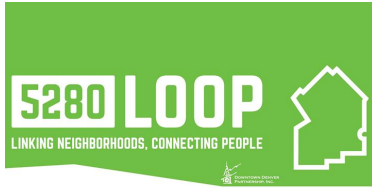
Current Mariposa Street
