Towards a Framework for Effective Interorganizational Collaboration

A Fulbright grant from the United States Department of State Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs to analyze the operations and performance of social welfare interorganizational networks in Hong Kong. In a mixed method, case study research design, whole-network, dyad and organizational measures were examined through network analysis, and analyzed with interview data from community nonprofits within the network. Given the extensive reliance upon interorganizational networks, it is critical that organizations can continue to collaborate within such networks as effectively and efficiently as possible for a maximum impact in the community. The research findings will help to inform the development of a framework for effective interorganizational network structures.

Partners for Healthy Child Development: A Study of Public Health Partnership Performance

A grant for dissertation and junior faculty research from the National Coordinating Center for Public Health Systems and Services Research with funding from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation as part of *Assuring the Future of Public Health Systems Research Dissertation and Junior Faculty Awards*. In a mixed method, cross case research design, the study measured the characteristics and attributes of interorganizational

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relationships within five stakeholder networks. The relational and network measures of the networks were examined through social network analysis (SNA) and qualitative content analysis, and analyzed with performance measures based on stakeholder assessments, ratings of perceived effectiveness by network members, and early intervention data. The study findings provided new empirical evidence about how different network characteristics and attributes affect performance, adding to a much needed knowledge base to guide the use, formation and management of intergovernmental relationships in the quest for improving health outcomes in America.
